Meet the leader

Bubba Watson, 35, recorded his second win of the season and secured his second Green Jacket in three years at the 2014 Masters Tournament. Watson's convincing victory and second career major championship represented his sixth PGA TOUR title. It vaulted him to a career-best fourth in the Official World Golf Ranking. His current world ranking is No. 5. A resident of Windermere, Fla., Watson has competed in 10 PGA TOUR events in the 2013-14 season and recorded six top-10 finishes, including a win at the Northern Trust Open to go with his Masters victory. He is currently ranked No. 2 on TOUR in FedExCup points and on the money list, with \$4,557,079 – raising his career earnings to \$23,275,997.

Satellite radios are available in Nationwide Live Studio, Golf Shops and the Patron Information Center Thursday through Sunday while supplies last.



The PGA TOUR's season-long FedExCup points competition is a thrilling showcase for golf's biggest names. Past champions include: Tiger Woods, Vijay Singh, Jim Furyk, Bill Haas, Brandt Snedeker and 2013 winner Henrik Stenson. The 2014 FedExCup season once again promises weekly intrigue as the excitement builds throughout the year. Golfers are tested through 39 weeks of regular season play, setting up the pressure packed Playoffs. — a four tournament post-season that's progressively more intense each week. The Playoffs narrow 125 players down to the final 30 who will play for it all at The TOUR Championship by Coca-Cola. The winner of this week's Memorial Tournament will receive 500 FedExCup points. Will your favorite player have what it takes to prove he was born for this challenge? Don't miss a moment of FedExCup action.

CELL PHONE POLICY

Cell phones and mobile devices are permitted on the property, yet please recognize that their use is expressly restricted. The Memorial Tournament has instituted a "zero tolerance" policy for any breach of these restrictions. At ALL times please keep your cell phone in the "silent" mode. During the four competitive rounds, mobile devices are not permitted for use any closer to the field of play than the paved cart paths and only then to access data. Voice usage is restricted to designated areas, which include: all concession and merchandise areas and digital hub locations. Mobile device photography is permitted during practice rounds but is prohibited throughout the official competition starting with the first round of the Memorial Tournament. Capturing video is prohibited throughout Tournament week. To ensure an enjoyable experience for fans and the proper competitive environment for players, the Memorial Tournament reserves the right to confiscate phones or devices from violators of this policy. Confiscated phones can be retrieved at the completion of play at Lost and Found, which is located within the Patron Information tent located on the Service Drive, adjacent to the Memorial Pavilion.

NO CAMERAS, PAGERS, BACKPACKS OR LARGE PURSES

As an added convenience to patrons, a Patron Information Center is located on the Service Drive, adjacent to the Memorial Pavilion. The volunteers staffing the center will be able to answer your questions concerning the Tournament and course. You will also be able to leave messages and receive EMERGENCY messages. SPECTATOR COURTESIES

Your courteous cooperation with the marshals and other officials will be greatly appreciated. Here are some guidelines on how to ensure maximum enjoyment for yourself and your fellow patrons.

PLEASE:

- · Walk at all times never run.
- · Be quiet and still as golfers play their shots.
- Don't leave green areas until all players in a group have putted out.
- Do not approach or talk to players on the golf course, no matter how well you may know them.
- Cross fairways only at designated areas, and stay behind the ropes at all other times.
- · Place all refuse in the receptacles provided.
- Be as considerate of your fellow spectators as you would like them to be of you.
- Heckling, signs and clothing with messaging deemed disruptive to play are not permitted and will result in spectator removal and relinquishment of Tournament credentials.

SAFE RIDE VOUCHERS

Complimentary Central Ohio Safe Ride vouchers are available from beverage servers and safety personnel for Patrons who need a safe ride home from the Tournament. Phone numbers of participating taxi companies are listed on the vouchers, and taxi cabs will be staged in the 6th tee parking lot off of Dublin Road.
